This is a reminder that the applications for the 2025 Royalty Contest are due at the **Fair Office** on Thursday, May 1, 2025, by 4:30 p.m. The forms are available at the fair office and on the preblecountfair.com website.

### Market Sheep and Market Goat

The Mandatory Market Goat and Sheep Tag-In/Weigh-In are fast approaching. They will be held on Sunday, May 4, 2025, from 1 to 4 p.m. at the Sheep Barn. This is for market goats and market lambs only. Do not bring your nonmarket goats or nonmarket sheep to this tag-in. **The home page of the preblecountfair.com website provides specific information and instructions on market sheep and market goat tagging.**

\*\*\*\*\* Exhibitors need to make sure they have completed the checkoff items below. \*\*\*\*\*

### Market Lamb/Market Sheep Checklist

☐ Enter your market goats/market lambs into Fair Entry ***no later than Thursday, May 1, 2025.*** (If you tagged in a Market Beef animal in January, you use the same login credentials when you entered your Market Beef animal.)

Please note \*\* When you add animal details for sheep and goats, be sure the entire scrapie tag is entered in the field identified for the scrapie tag number.

☐ Please complete the market tagging form BEFORE you arrive to the weigh-in. Turn the completed form in at the weigh-in on Sunday, May 4th, from 1 to 4 p.m. in the Sheep Barn. The form is available at the fair office or can be downloaded from the preblecountfair.com homepage.

☐ Please bring \$12/animal in cash or check (Payable to PCAS) to the weigh-in to cover the cost of the EID tag and the DNA collection tube.

☐ If you have a County-Born and Raised Market Lamb or Goat, turn the completed and signed County-Born and Raised Market Animal Form in with you to tag in.

**To avoid holdups and for respect of other exhibitors' time, if these steps are not completed, the exhibitor will have to step out of line and complete all the necessary information and then return to the back of the line.**

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### Market Hogs

Please remember that exhibitors taking junior fair market hogs must do the following:

- ☐ Purchase the EID Tag and DNA Collection Tube from the fair office. (These items are \$6 each and can be sold separately if your pig already has an EID tag in its ear. )
- ☐ Have a family member, advisor, or someone familiar with the tagging process collect the DNA and put the EID tag in the animal's ear.
- ☐ Complete the market animal form. The completed form and the DNA collection tube are due on Sunday, May 4, 2025. (The form can be obtained at the fair office or downloaded at [preblecountyfair.com](http://preblecountyfair.com).) *Those folks turning in their swine form and DNA on Sunday, May 4, 2025, will drop it off at the check-in table at the sheep and goat tag.*
- ☐ Enter junior market hogs into Fair Entry ***no later than Thursday, May 1, 2025.*** *(If you tagged in a Market Beef animal in January, you use the same login credentials when you entered your Market Beef animal.)*

Please note \*\* When you add animal details for your market hog project into FairEntry, enter the entire 15-digit EID Tag number in the RFID number field.
